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Restaurant Costa Azul up for sale

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The owner of Costa Azul has put the large restaurant on the market.

[Juan Fragozo](#) started serving Mexican food in the Southgate Plaza 18 years ago.

Before that, it was Tahiti Chinese Buffet, and the wok stations from that restaurant remain in the very large kitchen.

The space has a full bar and four main rooms. The restaurant sometimes features live music, and the place can accommodate 375 people.

The restaurant is at 7218 Franklin Blvd., which is near the corner of Florin Road.

The 7,625-square-foot restaurant is being offered at \$1.25 million, said [Brian Jacks](#), regional director with East West Commercial, which is representing the owner.
